SUMMARY

Abolishes annual one-hour change in time from standard time to daylight saving time and maintains Oregon on daylight saving time except in portion of Oregon in Mountain Time Zone. Becomes operative at 2 a.m. on first Sunday of first November in which standard of time in California and Washington is one hour in advance of United States standard of time for California and Washington. *November 7, 2021, which is first Sunday in November 2021.*

Refers Act to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

Repeals elimination of annual one-hour change in time and restores existing law if changes in standards of time have not become operative by December 1, 2029.
