SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to make publicly available specified information about payments to and expenditures by coordinated care organizations, authority and Department of Human Services. Requires authority to create and publish annual per capita cost report for all coordinated care organizations that includes specified information about costs incurred by coordinated care organizations.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure requires that certain information, which currently may be exempt from public disclosure as a trade secret under ORS 192.345 (2), be made publicly available and specifies that the information is not a trade secret under Oregon public records law.

This measure would make those public records that could be subject to public disclosure subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law.
