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SUMMARY

Grants to Oregon Health Authority powers to regulate financial condition of coordinated care organizations that align with powers of Department of Consumer and Business Services to regulate domestic insurers.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure a complaint filed with the Oregon Health Authority against a coordinated care organization regarding its financial condition, the record of the complaint and any data gathered during the subsequent investigation.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain additional information regarding complaints and investigations of complaints conducted by the Oregon Health Authority examining the financial condition of coordinated care organizations. Trade secret information of coordinated care organizations would more likely be made public.
