**Measure Description:**

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Department of Administrative Services to increase size and diversity of group of court appointed special advocates.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Administrative Services (DAS)

**Analysis:**

The measure would appropriate \$8,337,637 to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) out of the General Fund in the 2019-21 biennium, in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other appropriation. DAS would allocate these funds to Court Appointed Special Advocate Volunteer Programs for the purpose of recruiting, training and supervising a larger and more diverse group of court appointed special advocates.

The measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
