Measure Description:

Prohibits person from organizing, sponsoring, promoting, conducting or participating in contest, competition, tournament or derby that has objective of taking wildlife for prizes or other inducement or for entertainment.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon State Police (OSP), Counties, Department of Justice (DOJ), Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
