WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs Youth Development Division (Division) to administer a pilot program to coordinate the delivery of services to youth between 6 and 21 years of age via Youth Development Hubs. Requires program to establish at least five Hubs, and that Hubs be located in at least five different counties. Requires Division to develop standards including guidelines for selecting Hub entities. Requires Division to consider the entities: 1) ability to engage community; 2) produce outcomes; 3) resourcefulness; and 4) use, or proposed use, of evidence-based practices. Requires Division to report on pilot program no later that September 15, 2024. Repeals Act on December 31, 2025.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Youth Development Division is in the Oregon Department of Education. The purpose of the Division is to ensure that services are provided to school-age children through youth 24 years of age in a manner that supports educational success, focuses on crime prevention, reduces high-risk behaviors, and is integrated, measurable, and accountable.

HB 2644 directs Youth Development Division to administer a pilot program to coordinate the delivery of services to youth between 6 and 21 years of age via Youth Development Hubs.
