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Measure Description:

Outlines requirements for identifying grape varieties on wine labels and what percentage of wine, by volume, must be derived from that grape variety. Allows the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to form an advisory committee and adopt rules regarding wine labeling requirements and grape variety classifications.
