Measure Description:

Requires that wine using American viticultural area in this state as appellation of origin or implying American viticultural area as source be produced entirely from grapes grown in that American viticultural area. Allows the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to form an advisory committee and adopt rules regarding wine labeling requirements.
