Measure Description:

Requires all investigations involving suspected abuse or sexual conduct by school employees to be conducted by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education (ODE), Department of Human Services (DHS), Education Service Districts (ESD), School Districts, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure requires all investigations involving suspected abuse or sexual conduct by school employees to be conducted by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Oregon Department of Education, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, Education Service Districts, and School Districts.
