#### **Measure Description:**

Directs Office of Emergency Management to study and make recommendations regarding possible improvements to operations of office.

## **Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Military Department (OMD), Department of Aviation, Office of the Governor, Bonding

### **Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Office of Emergency Management of the Oregon Military Department to study and make recommendations regarding its operations and report back to the Legislature by January 1, 2021. The measure also directs the Department of Aviation to develop a list of preparedness equipment needed throughout airport facilities in Oregon to respond to local and regional emergencies, and to develop and administer a grant program to distribute preparedness equipment or funds to purchase such equipment. In addition, the bill authorizes the issuance of \$15.0 million in Article XI-Q bonds for purchase of emergency preparedness equipment.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Military Department and the Department of Aviation.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
