Measure Description:

Directs Department of Human Services to accomplish various objectives to improve positions and skills of child welfare services employees.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure makes various changes to child welfare caseworker training and support.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Human Services(DHS). A preliminary estimate from DHS projects a 2019-21 fiscal impact of \$1,722,091 General Fund and \$434,792 Federal Funds for twelve positions (9.00 FTE).

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
