Measure Description:

Directs Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to establish pilot program allowing public employees to obtain health services from coordinated care organizations.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Public Employees' Benefit Board (PEBB) and the Oregon Educators Benefit Board (OEBB) to establish a pilot program allowing public employees to obtain health services from coordinated care organizations starting in plan year beginning on January 1, 2020. In addition, the measure requires PEBB, OEBB, and the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) to establish a pilot program to consolidate health insurance plans offered by PEBB, OEBB, and the state medical assistance program.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
