**Measure Description:**

Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules governing processing and sale of beef and lamb that does not travel in interstate commerce.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on agriculture and Land Use to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation requires the Department of Agriculture (ODA) to adopt rules for the processing and sale of beef and lamb that does not travel in interstate commerce, except for exceptions provided for in the bill, ODA may adopt rules that diverge from Federal Meat Inspection Act.

The bill is anticipated to have an impact on ODA related to rule adoption and consultation with USDA. A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
