## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates \$3 million to Oregon State University (OSU) to develop, implement, and operate a website to provide information relating to chemical and nonchemical solutions for plant pest problems. Declares emergency, effective on July 1, 2019.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- OSU's statewide extension services
- Pest control for plants
- Pesticide run-off in urban areas
- Value-neutral information on pesticides
- Ability to provide season-specific information on a website
- Timing issues related to applying pesticides
- Protecting beneficial predators
- Lack of easy-to-understand information on pesticides and pest control
- Natural pest solutions
