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Measure Description:

Requires eight percent of electricity sold in this state by each electric company that makes sales to 25,000 or more retail electricity consumers to be generated by small-scale renewable energy facilities or certain biomass facilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Public Utility Commission (PUC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Energy and Environment to the House Committee on Rules.

The legislation makes changes to existing laws related to public utilities and energy facilities regulated by the Public Utility Commission.
