WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands the privately conducted hearings by district school boards to include hearings pertaining to any confidential school records, unless the student or the student's parent or guardian requests a public hearing.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Makes Oregon statute consistent with Federal requirements
- Oregon law currently prohibits exclusion
- Allows exception with parent or guardian permission

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Replaces the measure.

BACKGROUND:

Current statute requires any hearing held by a district school board on matters pertaining to, or examination of, confidential medical records of a student, including that student's educational program, shall be held in private.

House Bill 2514 A, expands this requirement to include hearings that pertain to, or examine, any confidential records of a student, not only medical records.
