WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates \$1,000,000 from General Fund to Youth Development Division for grants to community-based youth development programs. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Youth Development Division (YDD) is within the Oregon Department of Education. It provides services to school-age children and youths up to 24 years of age to support educational success, with a focus on crime prevention and reducing high-risk behaviors. According to YDD, 17,506 Oregon youths ages 16 to 21 do not have a high school diploma or GED and are not enrolled in school.

Senate Bill 264 appropriates \$1,000,000 from the General Fund to YDD for grants to community-based youth development programs.
