Measure Description:

Repeals statutory authority for nonunanimous jury verdicts in criminal trials.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Department of Justice (DOJ), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Department of Corrections (DOC), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure repeals the statutory authority for nonunanimous jury verdicts in criminal trials.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), the Department of Justice (DOJ), the Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), the Department of Corrections (DOC), the District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs) and the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD).
