Measure Description:

Provides that an owner, operator or lessee of an active quarry or mine located on property adjacent to the Willamette River in Polk County and across the Willamette river from the City of Keizer is liable for injuries resulting from bullets from a firearm discharged on the property that stray outside the boundaries of the property if, after being notified that bullets from a firearm discharged on the property have strayed outside the boundaries of the property, the owner, operator or lessee of the property fails to take reasonable measures to prevent any additional bullets from a firearm discharged on the property from straying outside the boundaries of the property.
