Measure Description:

Directs State Court Administrator to study issues relating to court records and report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2020.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure directs the State Court Administrator to study issues relating to court records and to report to Legislature no later than December 31, 2020.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Judicial Department, District Attorneys and the Oregon State Police.
