Measure Description:

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on relationship between recidivism rates and sentence imposed and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), Department of Corrections (DOC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct a study on the relationship between recidivism rates and the sentence imposed and to report on the findings to the Legislature on or before September 15, 2020.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Criminal Justice Commission and the Department of Corrections.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
