SUMMARY

Allows defendant in eviction action to apply for order setting aside judgment.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure requires a court to seal the records of an eviction action upon the filing of a motion by the defendant if the defendant has satisfied any money award included in a restitution judgment and five years have passed since the judgment, if it was a judgment by stipulation and the defendant has complied with its terms and satisfied any money award included in the stipulated agreement, or if the judgment was for dismissal in favor of the defendant.

Currently, records of eviction actions are subject to mandatory public disclosure.
