SUMMARY

Removes prohibition on payment of unemployment insurance benefits to nonprofessional employees of educational institution providing facilities or janitorial services for weeks of unemployment commencing during period between two successive academic years or terms.

Prohibits employer that is this state or political subdivision of this state from informing employee that employee is ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits unless Director of Employment Department has determined that employee is ineligible. Requires employer that is this state or political subdivision of this state to provide employees with any information about eligibility for benefits that is provided to employer by director. Authorizes employer that is this state or political subdivision of this state to provide employees with any other information about eligibility for benefits that is approved by director.
