**Measure Description:**

Provides that state appeal from order allowing demurrer must be decided by appellate court within prescribed time limits.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Justice (DOJ), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Department of Corrections (DOC), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
