**Measure Description:**

Prohibits person from conducting or participating in contest, competition, tournament or derby that has objective of taking coyotes for prizes or other inducement .

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Oregon State Police (OSP), Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Department of Justice (DOJ), Counties, Cities

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
