Measure Description:

Creates urban flood safety and water quality district in portion of Multnomah County within urban growth boundary adopted by Metro, for purposes of managing and improving levee system, drainage and natural areas to provide for flood safety and contribute to water quality, habitat and landscape resiliency.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Metro, Cities, Counties, Office of the Governor, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Water Resources Department (WRD), Department of Revenue (DOR)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue to the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures.
