SUMMARY

Provides that name and address of prize winner of certain lottery games are confidential and may not be publicly disclosed by Oregon State Lottery Commission or Oregon State Lottery unless prize winner provides written authorization for disclosure.

Provides that Oregon State Lottery may pay prize to trustee of trust at request of prize winner.

Authorizes commission to specify service fees that may be charged for lottery tickets or shares.

Prohibits commission from initiating or operating game for which tickets or shares may be purchased via Internet or personal electronic device.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure by the Oregon State Lottery Commission and the Oregon State Lottery the name and address of a prize winner of the multistate numbers drawing lottery games Mega Millions and Powerball.

Currently names and addresses of Oregon lottery prize winners are subject to mandatory public disclosure.
