**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Appropriates \$2,500,000 from General Fund to transportation grant program awarded to school districts when district does not receive any distribution in State School Fund for transit activities. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

House Bill 4130 (2018) established a matching grant fund for school districts to offset transportation costs. It allocated \$250,000 to fund the matching provision, allowing a dollar-for-dollar match. House Bill 2326 funds the program using \$2,500,000 from the General Fund.
