SUMMARY

Allows certain health care practitioner who receives needlestick injury during provision of medical care to patient who is unconscious or otherwise unable to consent to perform blood draw on patient for purpose of determining whether health care practitioner needs to begin any post-exposure prophylactic treatment.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
