Measure Description:

Prohibits name of Secretary of State, county clerk or filing officer from appearing in official capacity on voters' pamphlet, return identification envelope, secrecy envelope or other ballot information provided to electors if secretary, county clerk or filing officer is on ballot.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Secretary of State (SOS), Counties

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are anticipated to be minimal - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis:

SB 670 - B prohibits the name of the Secretary of State, county clerk or filing officer from appearing on various elections materials if they are a candidate in that election.

Secretary of State anticipates no fiscal impact as a result of this measure. Counties report that it will cost approximately \$60,000 in total, over the next two biennia, to reprint stocks of election materials.
