Measure Description:

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Analysis:

ORS 291.055(1)(e) requires all new state agency fees or fee increases adopted during the period beginning on the date of adjournment sine die of a regular session of the Legislative Assembly and ending on the date of adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly are rescinded on adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly unless authorized by enabling legislation setting forth the approved fees.

This bill provides the enabling legislation necessary to approve fees adopted through Administrative Rule by the Higher Education Coordinating Counsel (HECC) during the 2015-17 and 2017-19 Interims. Fees were adjusted for Private Career Schools program. These fee modifications are anticipated to create \$117,703 Other Funds revenue during the 2019-21 biennium. The 2019-21 budget for HECC assumes the continuation of the revenue from the fees included in this bill.
