WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Ratifies a new application fee of \$600 for an ignition interlock device service center adopted by the Oregon Department of Transportation and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services. This fee is related to the implementation of HB 2638 (2017).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Who pays
- Affordability

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Ratifies two other fee increases adopted by the Oregon Department of Transportation and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative services. Specifically, it increases the registration plate fee for a pair of plates from \$24.00 to \$24,50, and increases current fee for outdoor advertising signs by \$16 to \$44 depending on the size of the sign.

BACKGROUND:

ODOT is required to periodically review its fee structure and determine whether fees collected are adequate to maintain its programs. Additionally, HB 2638 (2017) related to the ignition interlock device program required the establishment of fees to fund the program.
