SUMMARY

Directs that Enrolled House Bill 3427, if referred by referendum petition, be submitted to people at special election held on January 21, 2020.

Prescribes method for creating ballot title and explanatory statement for any amendment to Oregon Constitution that passes both houses of Legislative Assembly during 2019 session and is referred to people by Legislative Assembly and for any Act that passes both houses of Legislative Assembly during 2019 regular session, if referred to people by either Legislative Assembly or by referendum petition.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure arguments related to a referral of Enrolled House Bill 3427 to the people, that are filed with the Secretary of State, until the fourth business day after the deadline for filing the argument.

Currently arguments for or against a referendum are available immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
