

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2012

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and in-
2 sert “and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a plan for a Medicaid Buy-In**
5 **program or a public option to provide an affordable health care option to the six percent of**
6 **Oregon residents who do not have access to health care. The plan must:**

7 **“(a) Have no net cost to the state;**

8 **“(b) Provide a comprehensive package of benefits that are, at a minimum, equivalent to**
9 **the benefits offered by qualified plans offered through the health insurance exchange;**

10 **“(c) Impose no more than minimal cost sharing, deductibles or copayments;**

11 **“(d) Take into account the impact on the distribution of risk in the health insurance**
12 **market;**

13 **“(e) Encourage the utilization of premium tax credits available under section 36B of the**
14 **Internal Revenue Code and other subsidies available under federal law;**

15 **“(f) Maximize the receipt of federal funds to support the costs of the program or option;**

16 **“(g) Utilize the coordinated care organization health care delivery model; and**

17 **“(h) Utilize the coordinated care organization provider networks to the extent possible**
18 **without destabilizing the networks.**

19 **“(2) No later than May 1, 2020, the authority shall report to the Legislative Assembly, in**
20 **the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the plan developed in accordance with subsection (1)**
21 **of this section including recommendations for legislative changes necessary to implement the**
22 **plan and any federal approval that will be required to implement the plan, such as demon-**
23 **stration projects under section 1115 of the Social Security Act, a state plan amendment or**
24 **a waiver for state innovation under 42 U.S.C. 18052.**

25 **“SECTION 2. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
26 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
