

# House Bill 2084

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Water Resources Department)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset date for Water Resources Department grant program for place-based integrated water resources strategies.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to place-based integrated water resources strategies; creating new provisions; amending  
3 section 3, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 3.** (1) Section 2, **chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015**, [*of this 2015 Act*] is repealed July 1,  
7 [2019] **2023**.

8 (2) The repeal of section 2, **chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015**, [*of this 2015 Act*] does not affect  
9 any rights or responsibilities established in a grant, contract or agreement made under section 2,  
10 **chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015**, [*of this 2015 Act*] prior to July 1, [2019] **2023**.

11 **SECTION 2.** **If this 2019 Act does not become effective until after June 30, 2019, the**  
12 **amendments to section 3, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015, by section 1 of this 2019 Act revive**  
13 **section 2, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015. If this 2019 Act does not become effective until**  
14 **after June 30, 2019, this 2019 Act shall operate retroactively to June 30, 2019, and section 2,**  
15 **chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015, shall continue unaffected from June 30, 2019, and thereafter.**  
16 **Any otherwise lawful action taken or otherwise lawful obligation incurred under authority**  
17 **of section 2, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2015, after June 30, 2019, and before the effective date**  
18 **of this 2019 Act is ratified and approved.**

19 **SECTION 3.** **This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**  
21 **on its passage.**
