

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2202

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 Delete lines 4 through 7 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall develop and administer a**
3 **program to conduct outreach to residents of Oregon who served in the Oregon National**
4 **Guard or a reserve component of the Armed Forces of the United States to:**

5 **“(a) Inform them about trade careers; and**

6 **“(b) Connect them with available apprenticeship opportunities.**

7 **“(2) The bureau may issue grants to trade unions and trade associations to be used to**
8 **conduct outreach through job fairs or similar recruitment methods.**

9 **“(3) The bureau may enter into one or more agreements with other state agencies, in-**
10 **cluding the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, the Employment Department and the Depart-**
11 **ment of Transportation, for the purpose of identifying individuals for outreach purposes.**

12 **“(4) The bureau shall adopt rules to administer and implement the provisions of this**
13 **section.**

14 **“SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, from the**
15 **Veterans’ Services Fund established under ORS 406.140, to the Bureau of Labor and Indus-**
16 **tries, the amount of \$250,000 for the purpose of implementing the provisions of section 1 of**
17 **this 2019 Act.**

18 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2021.**

19 **“SECTION 4. The Bureau of Labor and Industries may take any action before the oper-**
20 **ative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act that is necessary for the bureau to exercise,**
21 **on and after the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act, all of the duties,**
22 **functions and powers conferred on the bureau by section 1 of this 2019 Act.”.**

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
