

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2204

- 1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “management” insert “; and prescribing an effective date”.
2 Delete lines 4 through 7 and insert:
3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**
4 **“(a) ‘Law enforcement agency’ means an agency employing law enforcement officers to**
5 **enforce criminal laws.**
6 **“(b) ‘Reserve officer’ means an officer or member of a law enforcement agency who is:**
7 **“(A) A volunteer or employed less than full-time as a peace officer commissioned by a**
8 **city or county in this state;**
9 **“(B) Armed with a firearm; and**
10 **“(C) Responsible for enforcing the criminal laws or traffic laws of this state.**
11 **“(2) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall establish a pilot program to award a**
12 **grant to a law enforcement agency or local government to fund the creation and operation**
13 **of a reserve officer training academy.**
14 **“(3)(a) A law enforcement agency or local government may apply for a grant under this**
15 **section.**
16 **“(b) In the application, the law enforcement agency or local government shall:**
17 **“(A) Agree to operate a reserve officer training academy for a period of at least two**
18 **years; and**
19 **“(B) Agree to provide at least one complete training program per year the training**
20 **academy is open.**
21 **“(c) The training academy funded by a grant under this section:**
22 **“(A) May not consider the city or county law enforcement agency with which a reserve**
23 **officer is affiliated when accepting applicants to the training academy;**
24 **“(B) Shall provide training to reserve officers by authorized training personnel from**
25 **participating agencies; and**
26 **“(C) Is not required to provide training that would qualify a reserve officer for certi-**
27 **fication by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training under ORS 181A.355 to**
28 **181A.670.**
29 **“(4) In addition to the criteria under subsection (3) of this section, the commission shall**
30 **establish by rule the application process and any eligibility criteria for a grant.**
31 **“(5) The commission shall establish by rule the process of awarding a grant under this**
32 **section. No later than July 1, 2020, the commission shall award a grant to one eligible law**
33 **enforcement agency or local government in accordance with the rules established under this**
34 **section.**
35 **“SECTION 2. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall report on the progress of**

1 the reserve officer training academy pilot program established under section 1 of this 2019
2 Act, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim committee of the Legislative
3 Assembly related to emergency preparedness no later than September 15, 2022.

4 “SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2019 Act are repealed on January 1, 2025.

5 “SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
6 priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
7 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, to be expended for the purposes described
8 in section 1 of this 2019 Act.

9 “SECTION 5. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019
10 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.

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
