HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2229

2	sert "and".
3	Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall establish and administer a pilot
5	program to assist school districts in providing age-appropriate instruction on natural disas-
6	ters.
7	"(2) Instruction provided under the pilot program established by this section must:
8	"(a) Enable students to prepare for a natural disaster and survival in the days and weeks
9	after a natural disaster; and
10	"(b) Be specific to the natural disasters that may occur in the areas served by the
11	schools participating in the pilot program, and may include earthquakes, tsunamis, water
12	shortages, floods and heavy snow.
13	"(3) Any school district in this state may apply to participate in the pilot program es-
14	tablished by this section. The department shall select no more than five school districts to
15	participate in the pilot program. When selecting school districts to participate in the pilot
16	program, the department shall give priority to school districts that represent geographic and
17	demographic diversity.
18	"(4) For school districts participating in the pilot program established by this section, the
19	department shall:
20	"(a) Develop curriculum that may be used by the school districts; and
21	"(b) Provide any necessary technical assistance to the school districts.
22	"(5) The department shall submit a report to the appropriate interim committees of the
23	Legislative Assembly related to education no later than:
24	"(a) September 15, 2022, for a preliminary report; and
25	"(b) September 15, 2024, for a final report.
26	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
27	"SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
28	priated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the
29	General Fund, the amount of \$, which may be expended for developing curriculum and
30	providing technical assistance as described in section 1 of this 2019 Act.
31	"SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
32	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect

July 1, 2019.".
