AN ACT

Relating to the offense of unlawfully operating a low-speed vehicle on a highway; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 811.512.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 811.512 is amended to read:

- 811.512. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawfully operating a low-speed vehicle on a highway if the person operates a low-speed vehicle on a highway that has a speed limit or posted speed of more than 35 miles per hour.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a city or county may adopt an ordinance allowing operation of low-speed vehicles on city streets or county roads that have speed limits or posted speeds of more than 35 miles per hour.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a person does not commit the offense of unlawfully operating a low-speed vehicle on a highway if the person operates a farm tractor on a state highway that has a speed limit or posted speed of more than 35 miles per hour.
- [(3)] (4) The offense described in this section, unlawfully operating a low-speed vehicle on a highway, is a Class B traffic violation.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 811.512 by section 1 of this 2019 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.
