

# House Bill 2293

Sponsored by Representative WITT (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Amends residency requirements for purposes of licenses, tags and permits related to wildlife.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to residency requirements under wildlife statutes; amending ORS 497.002.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 497.002 is amended to read:

497.002. Except as provided in ORS 497.006, as used in this chapter:

(1)(a) "Resident" means a person who has **physically** resided in this state [*at least*] **for not less than** six consecutive months immediately prior to the date of making application for a license, tag or permit issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission. [*Temporary absence from the state for a purpose other than establishing residency outside the state shall not be considered in determining whether a person meets the residency requirements of this subsection.*]

(b) "Resident" **does not include a person who merely owns real property or pays property taxes in this state.**

(2) "Nonresident" means any person other than a resident.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
