House Bill 2293

Amends residency requirements for purposes of licenses, tags and permits related to wildlife.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 497.002 is amended to read:
5	497.002. Except as provided in ORS 497.006, as used in this chapter:
6	(1)(a) "Resident" means a person who has physically resided in this state [at least] for not less
7	than six consecutive months immediately prior to the date of making application for a license, tag
8	or permit issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission. [Temporary absence from the state for
9	a purpose other than establishing residency outside the state shall not be considered in determining
10	whether a person meets the residency requirements of this subsection.]
11	(b) "Resident" does not include a person who merely owns real property or pays property
12	taxes in this state.
13	(2) "Nonresident" means any person other than a resident.
