

House Bill 2368

Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies juvenile court dependency procedure to require Department of Justice to bear responsibility for certain expenses arising out of summonses issued by Department of Human Services.

2 Relating to juvenile court costs; amending ORS 419B.827.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 419B.827 is amended to read:

5 419B.827. The court may authorize payment of travel expenses of any party summoned. Except
6 as provided in this section, responsibility for the payment of the cost of service of summons or other
7 process on any party, and for payment of travel expenses so authorized, shall be borne by the party
8 issuing the summons or requesting the court to issue the summons. When the Department of Human
9 Services issues the summons or requests the court to issue the summons, responsibility for such
10 payment shall be borne by the *[county]* **Department of Justice**.
