House Bill 2376

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to State Parks and Recreation Department for outreach and development of educational signs warning public about natural dangers of ocean beaches. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to ocean beaches; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the

5 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for outreach

6 and development of educational signs that warn the public about the natural dangers of

7 ocean beaches, to be posted at key public beach access sites in this state.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
10 July 1, 2019.
