House Bill 2383

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys for distribution to Curry County assessor for pilot program to increase employment in assessor's office in order to achieve assessment rotation of seven years for taxable property.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to an appropriation for a tax assessment pilot program; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium be-

5 ginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$125,000 for distribution to the

6 Curry County assessor for the purpose of a pilot program that will increase employment in

7 the office of the assessor in order to achieve an assessment rotation of seven years for tax-

8 able property located in the county.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019
10 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
