4	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'servicemember' means a person who is a
5	member, or who served as a member, of the Armed Forces of the United States, the reserve
6	components of the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard.
7	"(2) At the time of arraignment on a criminal charge, the court shall inform the de-
8	fendant that the defendant's status as a servicemember may make the defendant eligible for
9	treatment programs, diversion, specialty courts or mitigated sentencing, and that the de-
10	fendant may obtain information about these options by consulting with the defendant's at-
11	torney.
12	"(3) In a criminal proceeding the defendant's attorney may, with the permission of the
13	defendant, notify the court that the defendant is a servicemember.
14	"(4) The fact that a defendant is a servicemember may not be used as an aggravating
15	factor in determining the defendant's sentence.".
