

# House Bill 2465

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Judiciary)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to study parole for certain inmates. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary.

Sunset January 2, 2020.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to parole for certain inmates; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. The State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision shall study the feasibility of releasing on parole inmates who have reached a certain age and who have completed at least 240 months of a sentence. The board shall submit findings and recommendations for legislation to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than December 31, 2019.**

**SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.**

**SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.**
