

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2512

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and line  
2 3 and insert “creating new provisions; and amending ORS 326.021.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 326.021 is amended to read:

5 “326.021. (1) The State Board of Education shall consist of:

6 “(a) The State Treasurer, or the designee of the State Treasurer;

7 “(b) The Secretary of State, or the designee of the Secretary of State; and

8 “(c) Seven members, appointed by the Governor for a term of four years beginning July 1 of the  
9 year of appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562  
10 and 171.565. A person appointed under this paragraph may not be appointed to serve consecutively  
11 more than two full terms as a board member.

12 “(2) In making appointments under subsection (1) of this section, the Governor shall select from  
13 residents of Oregon one member from each congressional district and two members from the state  
14 at large. [An] **One** appointed member [*may not*] **from the state at large must** be engaged in  
15 teaching [*or participate in the administration or operation of any school*] **as a licensed teacher in**  
16 **this state.**

17 “(3) The Governor may remove appointed members of the State Board of Education for cause  
18 at any time after notice and public hearing.

19 “(4) The State Treasurer and the Secretary of State, or the designee of the State Treasurer or  
20 Secretary of State, are nonvoting, ex officio members of the board.

21 “(5) The board shall coordinate and collaborate with the Chief Education Office as provided by  
22 section 1, chapter 519, Oregon Laws 2011.

23 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 326.021, as amended by section 42, chapter 774, Oregon Laws 2015, is  
24 amended to read:

25 “326.021. (1) The State Board of Education shall consist of:

26 “(a) The State Treasurer, or the designee of the State Treasurer;

27 “(b) The Secretary of State, or the designee of the Secretary of State; and

28 “(c) Seven members, appointed by the Governor for a term of four years beginning July 1 of the  
29 year of appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562  
30 and 171.565. A person appointed under this paragraph may not be appointed to serve consecutively  
31 more than two full terms as a board member.

32 “(2) In making appointments under subsection (1) of this section, the Governor shall select from  
33 residents of Oregon one member from each congressional district and two members from the state  
34 at large. [An] **One** appointed member [*may not*] **from the state at large must** be engaged in  
35 teaching [*or participate in the administration or operation of any school*] **as a licensed teacher in**

2       “(3) The Governor may remove appointed members of the State Board of Education for cause  
3 at any time after notice and public hearing.

4       “(4) The State Treasurer and the Secretary of State, or the designee of the State Treasurer or  
5 Secretary of State, are nonvoting, ex officio members of the board.

6       “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 326.021 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2019 Act apply**  
7 **to appointments to the State Board of Education made on or after the effective date of this**  
8 **2019 Act.”**
