

House Bill 2517

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits state agencies from suspending or revoking license required to pursue commercial activity, trade, occupation or profession because licensee is delinquent in paying student loan debt.

Relating to student loan debt.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. An agency of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, may not suspend or revoke a license required to pursue any commercial activity, trade, occupation or profession because the licensee is delinquent in paying student loan debt.
