

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2558

- 1 Delete lines 4 through 10 of the printed bill and insert:
2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Seismic Event Preparation is established.**
3 **“(2) The task force consists of nine members appointed as follows:**
4 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from among members of the**
5 **Senate.**
6 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one member from among**
7 **members of the House of Representatives.**
8 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint seven members as follows:**
9 **“(A) One member who represents the Office of Emergency Management;**
10 **“(B) One member who manages emergencies for a school district;**
11 **“(C) One member who represents the Department of Education;**
12 **“(D) One member who represents the Early Learning Division;**
13 **“(E) One member who represents the Department of Human Services for child welfare**
14 **services;**
15 **“(F) One member who is a mental health provider; and**
16 **“(G) One member who is the Governor’s Public Safety Policy Advisor.**
17 **“(3) The task force shall conduct a study regarding the impacts of a major seismic event**
18 **on children. As part of the study, the task force shall identify methods for preparing schools**
19 **and communities to meet the needs of children following a major seismic event.**
20 **“(4) When conducting the study described in subsection (3) of this section, the task force**
21 **shall consult with the Federal Emergency Management Agency.**
22 **“(5) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the**
23 **transaction of business.**
24 **“(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting**
25 **members of the task force.**
26 **“(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**
27 **“(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
28 **ment to become immediately effective.**
29 **“(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
30 **or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.**
31 **“(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**
32 **“(11) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**
33 **lation, to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later**
34 **than September 15, 2020.**
35 **“(12) The Department of Education shall provide staff support to the task force.**

1 **“(13) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task force are nonvoting**
2 **members of the task force and may act in an advisory capacity only.**

3 **“(14) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are**
4 **not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the**
5 **task force.**

6 **“(15) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
7 **the task force in the performance of the duties of the task force and, to the extent permitted**
8 **by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the task**
9 **force consider necessary to perform their duties.”.**

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
