

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2574

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 4, delete “establish”.
- 2 Delete line 5 and insert “receive, consolidate and organize the public”.
- 3 In line 7, after the period insert “The department shall establish an electronic system to store
4 and share the public record information.”.
- 5 In line 20, delete “collected” and insert “stored” and delete “information” and insert
6 “electronic”.
- 7 In line 23, delete the first “information” and insert “electronic”.
- 8 On page 2, delete lines 6 through 37 and insert:
- 9 **“SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 622.210 to
10 622.360.**
- 11 **“SECTION 4. (1) A prospective applicant for the cultivation of oysters, clams or mussels
12 shall, no later than 30 days prior to filing an application under ORS 622.250, participate in a
13 preapplication conference with the State Department of Agriculture and other appropriate
14 local, state and federal agencies.**
- 15 **“(2) Not less than 14 days before the preapplication conference, the prospective applicant
16 must provide the department with adequate information to prepare for the preapplication
17 conference.**
- 18 **“(3) At the preapplication conference, the department and other appropriate local, state
19 and federal agencies shall:**
- 20 **“(a) Inform the prospective applicant of statutes, administrative rules, local ordinances
21 and any other requirements that may apply to the application;**
- 22 **“(b) Based on the information provided by the prospective applicant and other annual
23 production data and information available to the department, discuss with the prospective
24 applicant projected revenue data and related matters; and**
- 25 **“(c) Assist the prospective applicant by identifying known issues that may affect the
26 likelihood that the prospective applicant will be able to meet any conditions placed on re-
27 quired permits from state agencies and local governments.**
- 28 **“(4) The prospective applicant may request additional preapplication consultation with
29 the department.**
- 30 **“SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
31 priated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out
32 of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, which may be expended for work related to
33 conducting preapplication conferences under section 4 of this 2019 Act.”.**
- 34 In line 38, delete “5” and insert “6”.
- 35 On page 3, line 6, delete “6” and insert “7”.

- 1 In line 9, delete "5" and insert "6".
- 2 In line 10, delete "7" and insert "8".
